Summary statement

As a consultant he has collaborated with the international office Baumschlager Eberle in two different periods. In the year 2010 at their office in Lochau, Austria, and between 2012 and 2015 at the office in Vaduz, Liechtenstein.

As Associate Professor he has taught for more than twenty years Design Projects in the School of Architecture of Madrid (ETSAM) at the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid (UPM). He has also been invited as lecturer or critic in a number of academic institutions, congresses and simposiums, nationally and internationally. Among them, the Technische Universität München and the Universität Liechtenstein.


